Emergency Contact Plan - Parents and Caregivers

In the event of an emergency at school, we have detailed Emergency Management Plan in place to best ensure the safety of students and staff. This plan had been prepared by Harrison Tew (Emergency Planning Specialists) in consultation with the School.

Emergency plans include several scenarios such as Fire, Earthquake and Lockdown to name a few.

Principles of Emergency Management

The School adheres to the emergency principles adopted by the emergency services and Auckland Civil Defence

- Reduction
- Readiness
- Responses
- Recovery

Types of Emergency at School

- 1. Lockdown where the school site 'locks down' ensuring all those onsite are safely inside the school buildings.
- 2. Evacuation where all those on the school site move to a safe outside location the main field.

If an Emergency occurs at school:
