## Maths Tasks

Find something to measure in your house. Measure the length with different objects like pencils, paperclips, a spoon	Build something with lego or other building blocks	Play with water using different shaped containers and measuring cups in the sink or bath	Bake something using a recipe - count how many teaspoons, how many cups etc	Have a picnic with your toys. Share items equally amongst them
Statistics fun Ask the people in your family what their favourite food is. Turn into a pictograph. Which one is the most popular/least popular?	Create your own jigsaw puzzle using pictures from old magazines. Think of the shapes you could make. Teach someone in your family to make it.	Count around your house. E.g. How many books are in your bookshelf? How many pairs of socks in your drawer?	Calendar Maths - e.g. Count forwards and backwards, how many days in a week? how many days/weeks in a month?	Create and play with a sorting box with all sorts of treasures like: bottle tops, shells, stones, toys, acorns, cardboard shapes, leaves
Complete a jigsaw puzzle	Do sums using objects like stones or marbles	Make a schedule of your day (to the hour and half hour)	Make up addition and subtraction problems with a pack of cards	Make fairy bread and cut into halves, quarters and thirds. Discuss equal sharing
Learn your birthday and the birthdays of everyone in your house. Put them onto a calendar	Measure your bedroom using your feet. How many 'feet'? Ask other members of your family to do the same. Is their number more or less?	Play skittles Save ten plastic bottles and write a number between one and ten on each.	Play boardgames	Do a shape search. Can you find circles, squares, rectangles, triangles and more in your house?
